PASCO Airlink2 (use with SPARKvue software on iPad/iPod) – Bluetooth connectivity of PASCO science probes displaying real time data on iPad/iPod – www.pasco.com

ProScope Mobile (Bodelin) wifi enabled digital microscope that broadcasts to iPads - <http://www.bodelin.com/proscopehr/>

Airscanner – app for iPhone – runs on iPad (\$4.99) that allows you to broadcast to computers via WiFi what is being viewed live through the built-in camera on the iPad2 or iPod.

Air Projector – app for iPad – stream presentations, images from photo library, etc. from iPad/iPhone to computers via WiFi

Snapkast - <http://snapkast.com/> - free trial, annotate, narrate while running a PowerPoint Presentation, then save as AVI movie file, publish directly to YouTube or TeachTube. (\$79.95)

Viewbix - www.viewbix.com (free) create links to other resources, instructions, comments buttons on YouTube Videos

QR Code Reader and Scanner – free QR Code Reader for iPad on iTunes store
QR Stuff - QR Code Generator (free) - use online to create and save QR Codes

Photsynth & Dermalander Panorama (both free) – create your own 3D panoramas using built in iPad camera

Tour Wrist – free app for iPad/iPod – choose sites around the world to see 360 degree panorama as you turn around with iPad in hand

Paperdesk Lite – (free) writing app for the iPad allowing voice recording, typing, handwriting with stylus, importing of images, create task lists, export or print pages.

Hovercam 3 - <http://assistivetek.blogspot.com/p/hovercam.html> - 3 MP document camera for Mac and PC. Record, built-in mic, extension arm allows camera to extend over books, etc.

2 IntelliSwitches connected to 1 computer – yes, you can connect up to 5 IntelliSwitches to 1 computer allowing 5 switch users to wirelessly engage in the same activity. This is accomplished by “pairing” each IntelliSwitch to the same USB Dongle. Directions on how to pair are found at <http://www.madentec.com/faq/?id=20>

Reader – free add-on for Firefox web browser extracts text from articles on website leaving ads, comments, headlines behind – similar to (free) InstaPaper which can be found at www.instapaper.com

Canson Papershow - <http://assistivetek.blogspot.com/p/featured-products.html> - USB dongle connects pen to computer to broadcast anything you write, draw take notes, into a whiteboard application to save, print notes.
